Hyperlinks: One URL can be added to each module section using SVG


How it will look

The image file will sit within the screen and adjust to the size of the screen



Adding SVG Files

When creating a **new section** in your modules within dita Creator, select **SVG** as the page type. Then select **Create Section**. Audio is added in the next step.




Add a Title Name

Don't forget to give your section a title - this will ensure you can distinguish it from other sections of your module

Adding SVG Files

Once your section is created, you can upload your **SVG file**. Simply click **Upload SVG** and select the file. This is where you can add an audio file also. Tick the **Add Audio Box** and **Upload Audio**.



Upload Your Files

Once your files have been uploaded, the image will populate so you can preview before saving.

Preview Your Files

Now that you have added your **SVG File** (and **Audio File** if using), you can add a **URL to the SVG** then preview the image to ensure it is correct. If you need to replace either file, simply click on the **upload** button again to replace.
